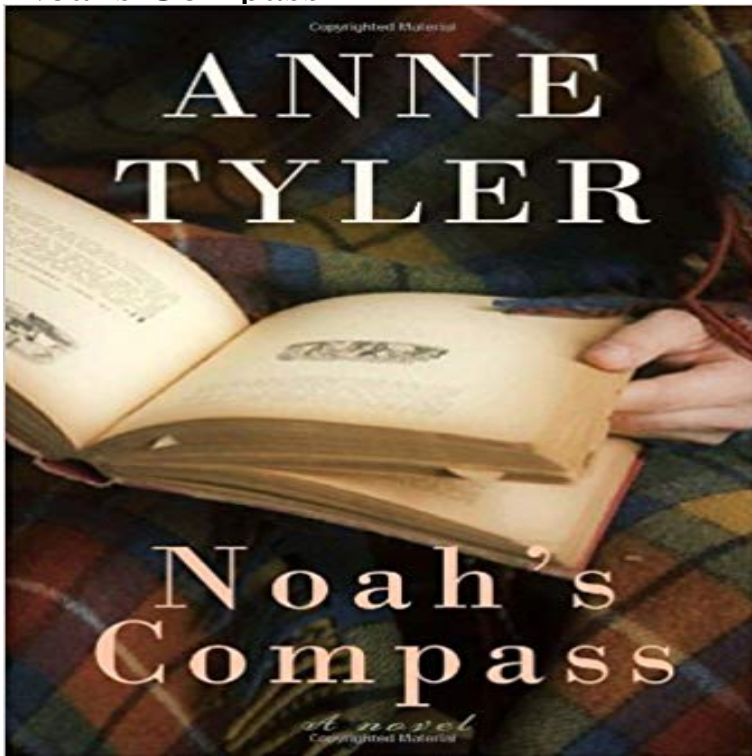


Noahs Compass
