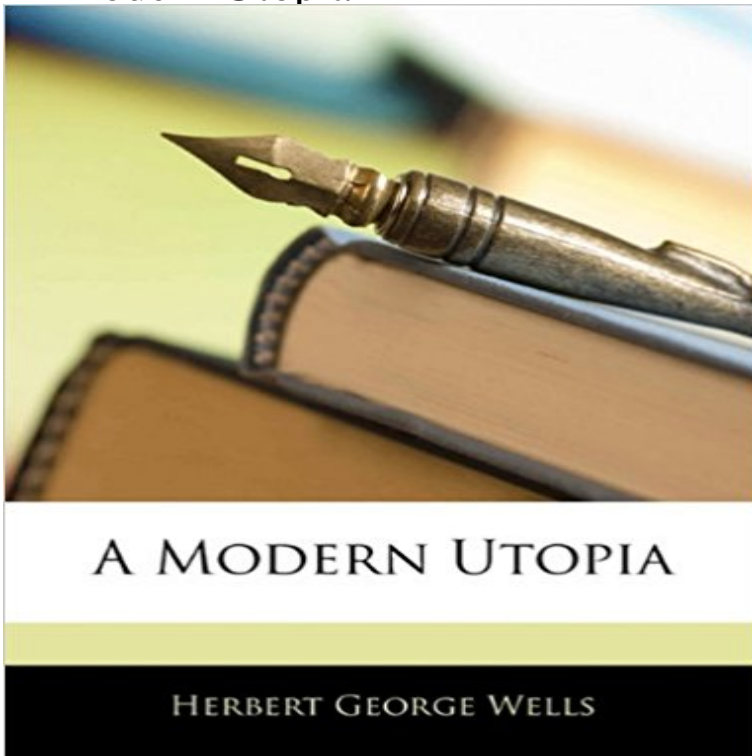


A Modern Utopia
