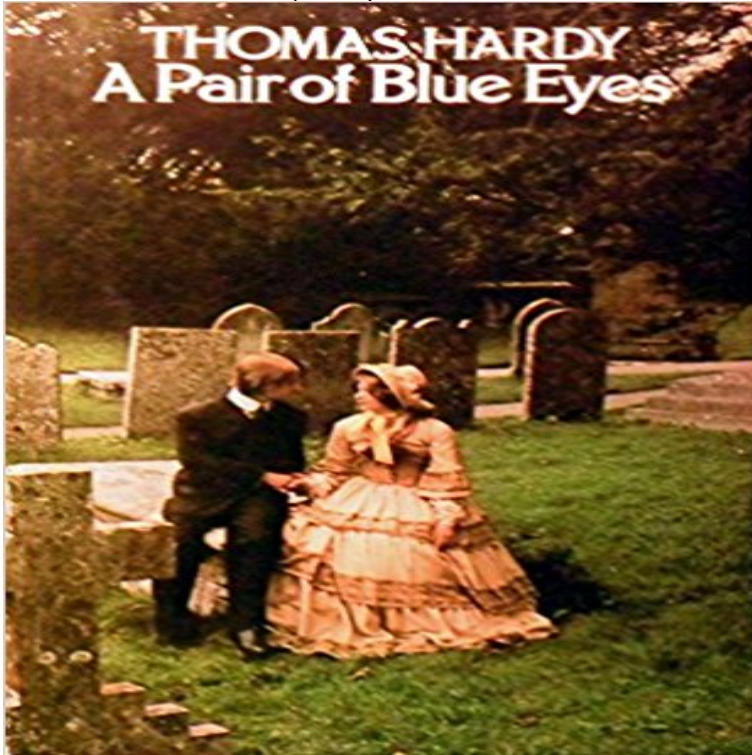


## Pair of Blue Eyes (The New Wessex edition)
