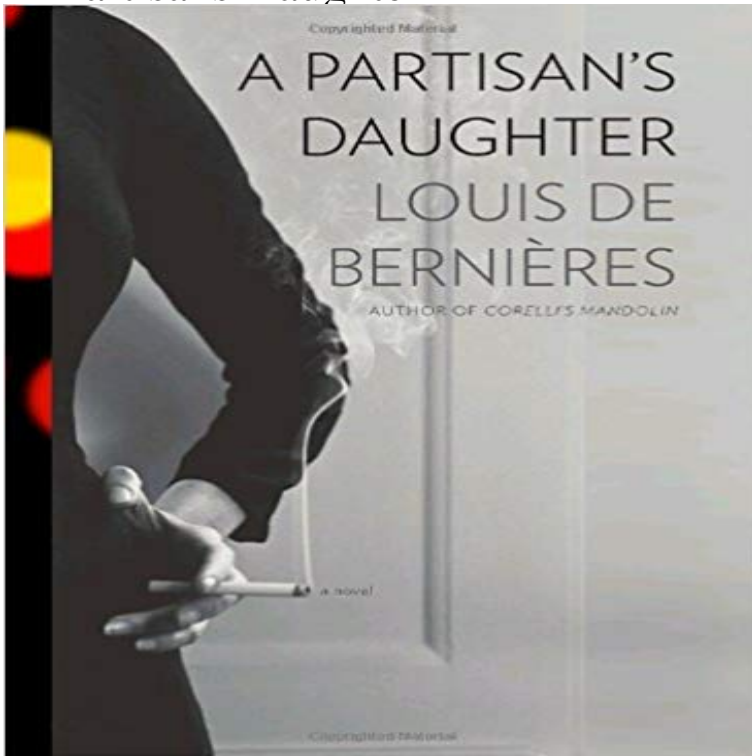


A Partisans Daughter

And although *shes not a hooker*, when *shes propositioned* by Chris, she gets into his car anyway. Over the next months Roza tells Chris the stories of her past. *Shes a fast-talking, wily Scheherazade*, saving her own life by telling it to Chris. And he takes in her tales as if they were oxygen in an otherwise airless world. But is Roza telling the truth? Does Chris hear the stories through the filter of his own need? Does it even matter? This deeply moving novel of their unlikely love narrated both in the moment and in recollection, each of their voices deftly realized is also a brilliantly subtle commentary on storytelling: its seductions and powers, and its ultimately unavoidable dangers.
