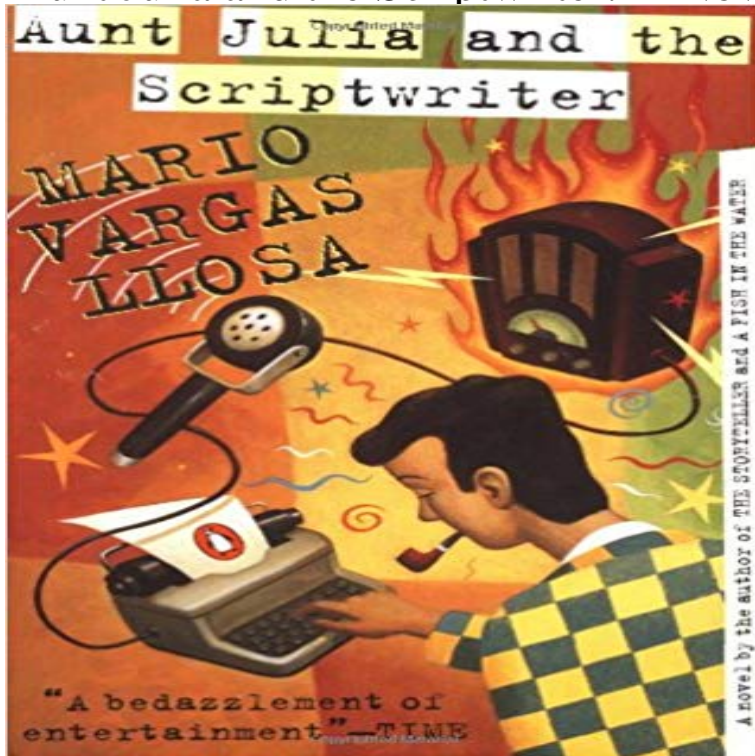


Aunt Julia and the Scriptwriter: A Novel
