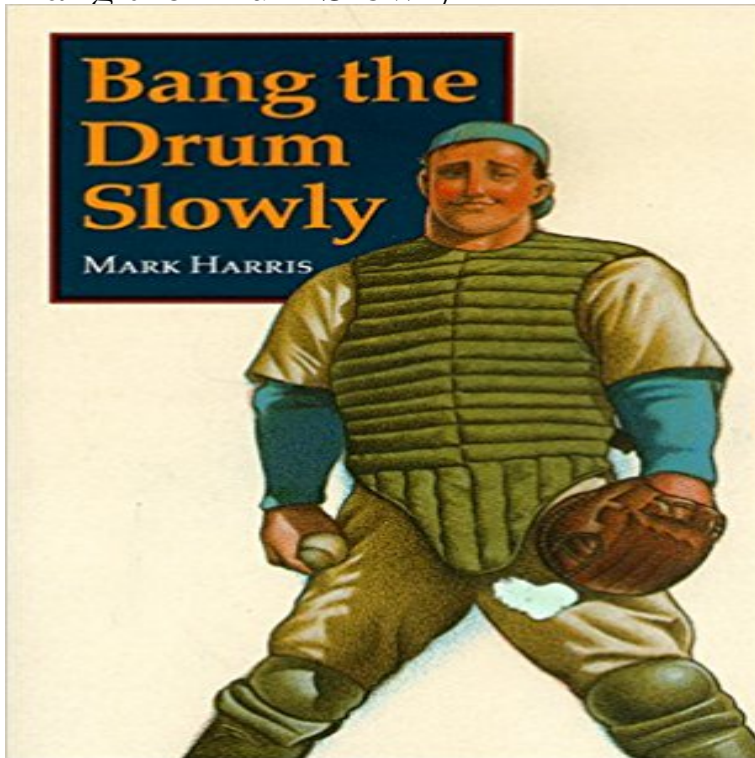


## Bang the Drum Slowly
