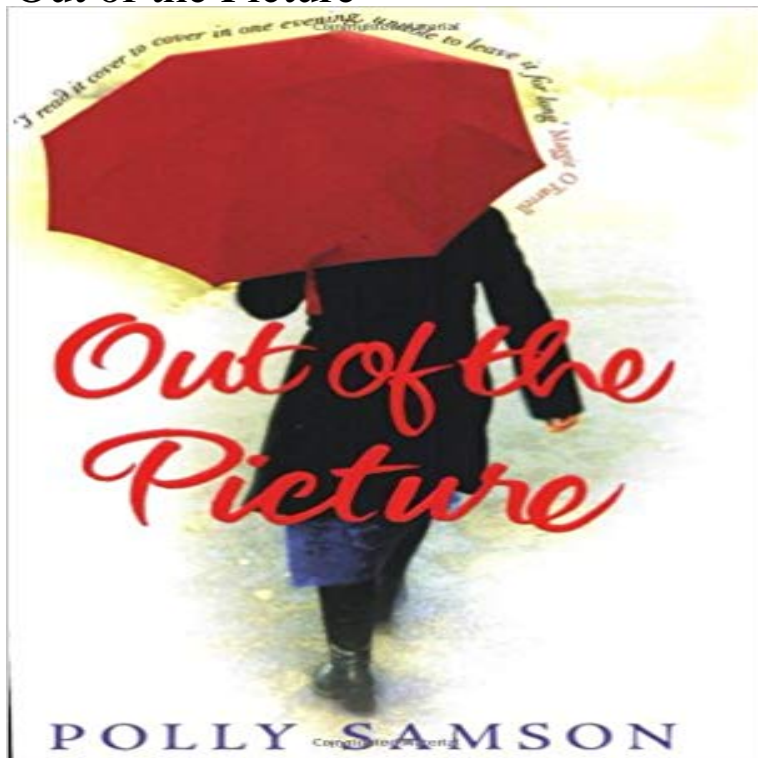


Out of the Picture
