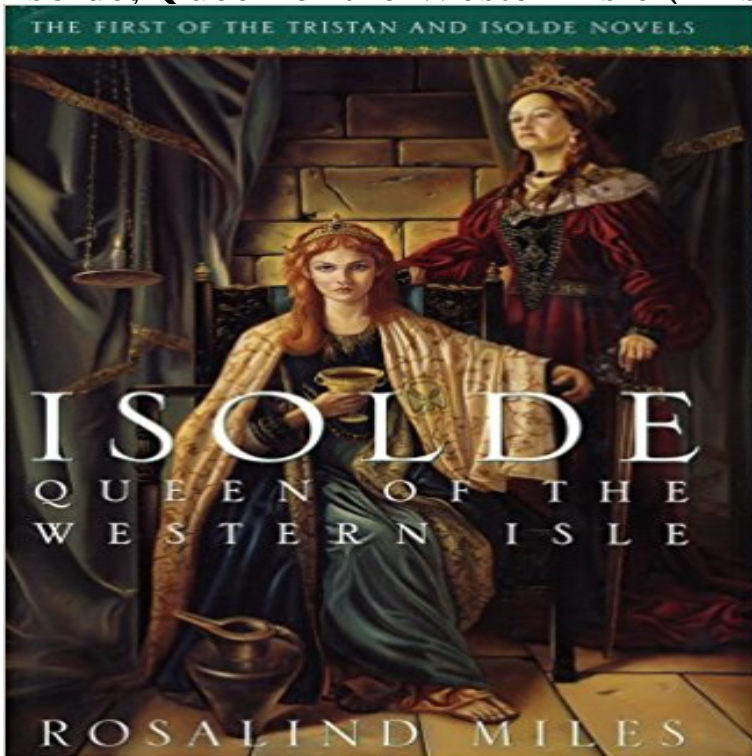


Isolde, Queen of the Western Isle (Tristan and Isolde Novels, Book 1)
