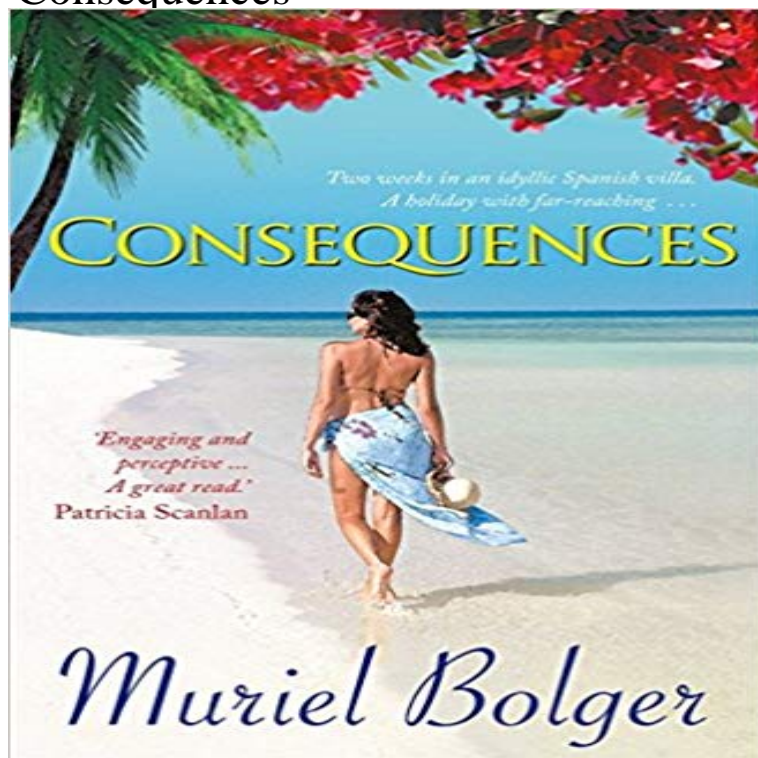


## Consequences
