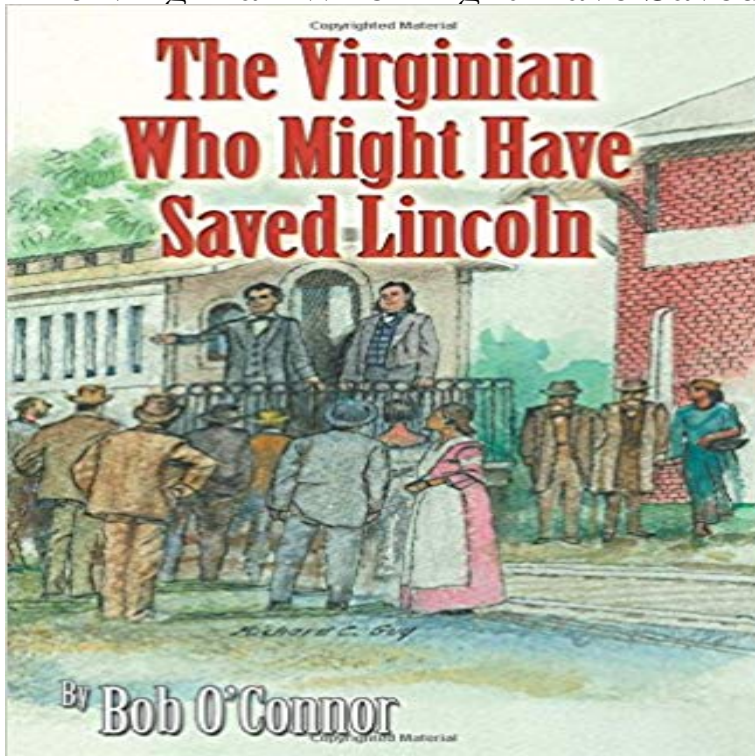


The Virginian Who Might Have Saved Lincoln
