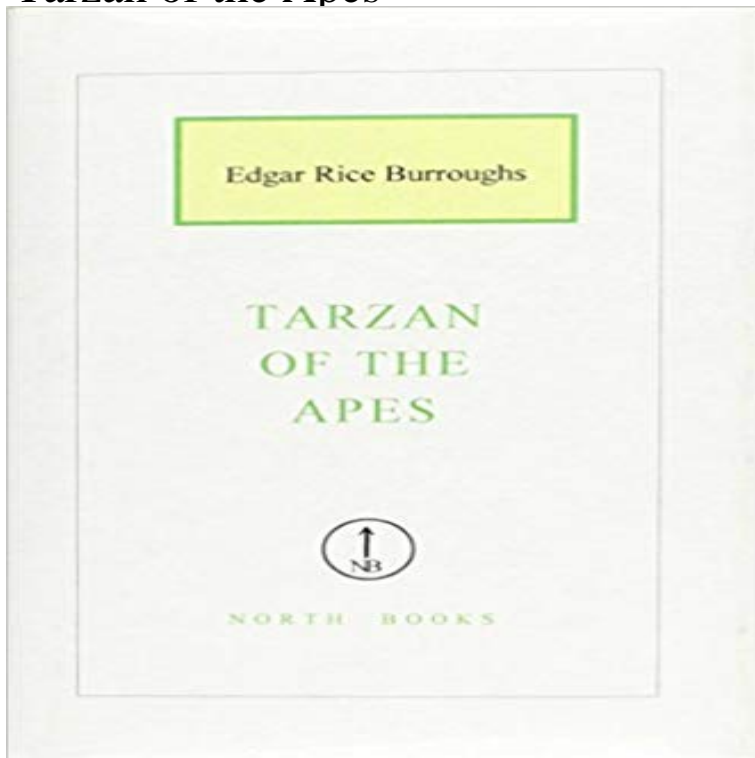


Tarzan of the Apes
