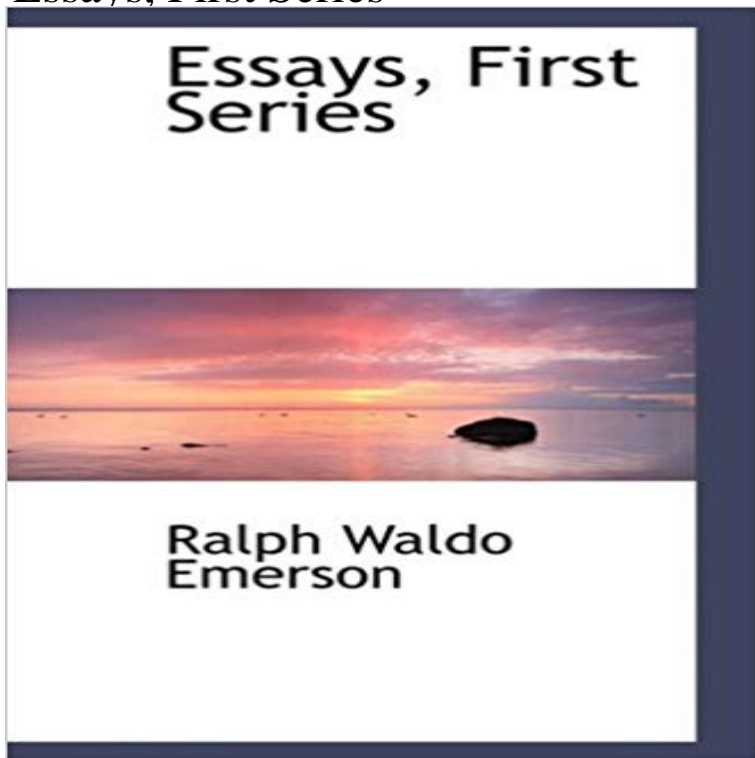


## Essays, First Series
