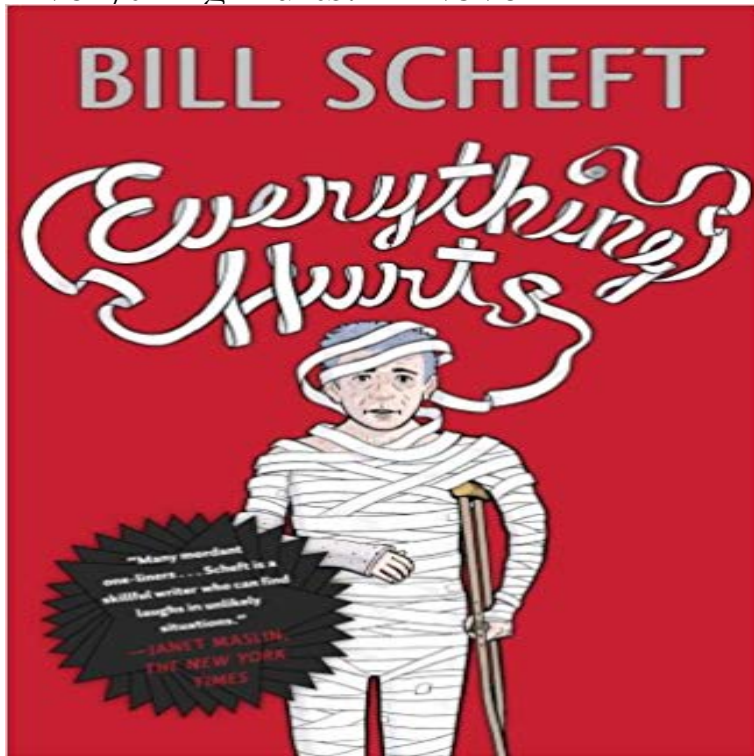


Everything Hurts: A Novel
