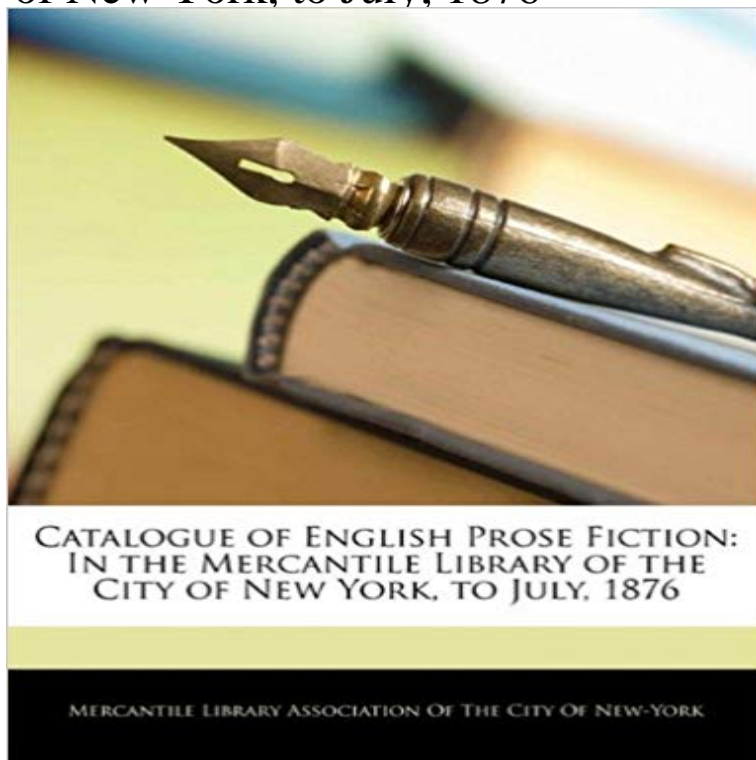


Catalogue of English Prose Fiction: In the Mercantile Library of the City of New York, to July, 1876
