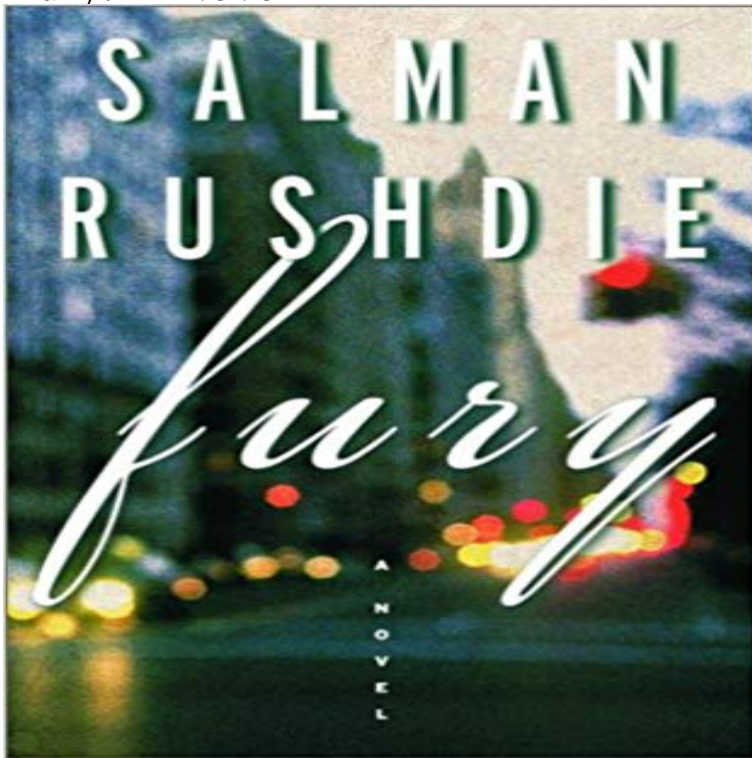


Fury: A Novel
