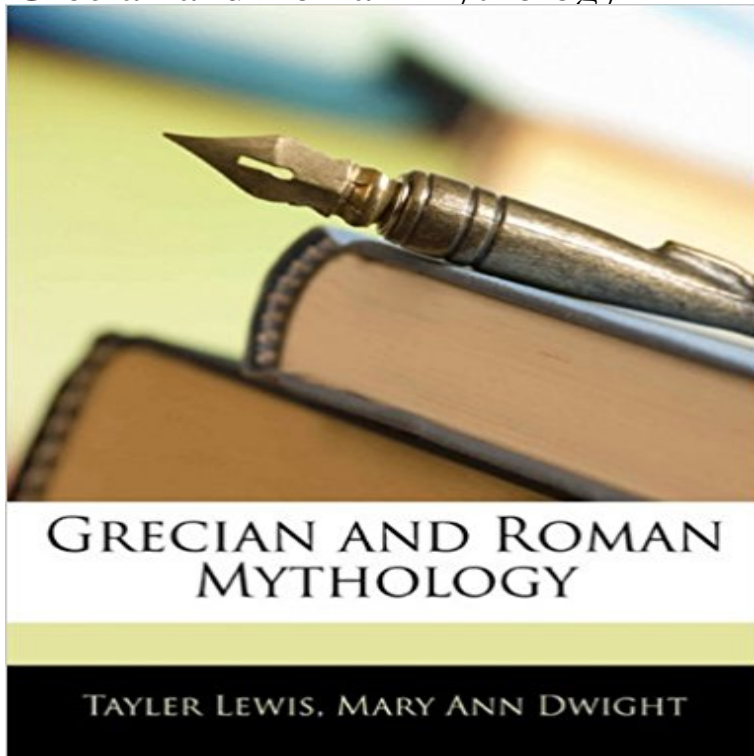


Grecian and Roman Mythology
