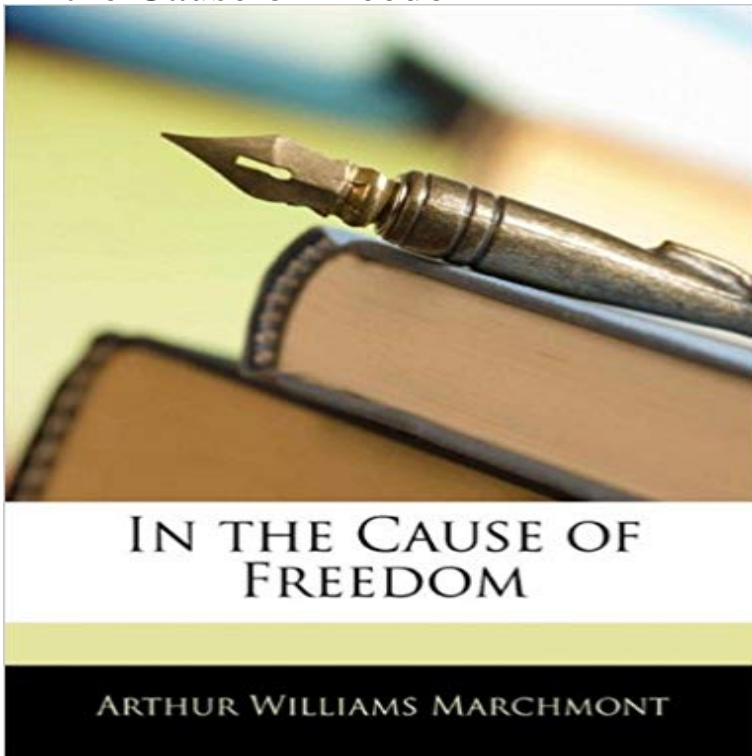


## In the Cause of Freedom
