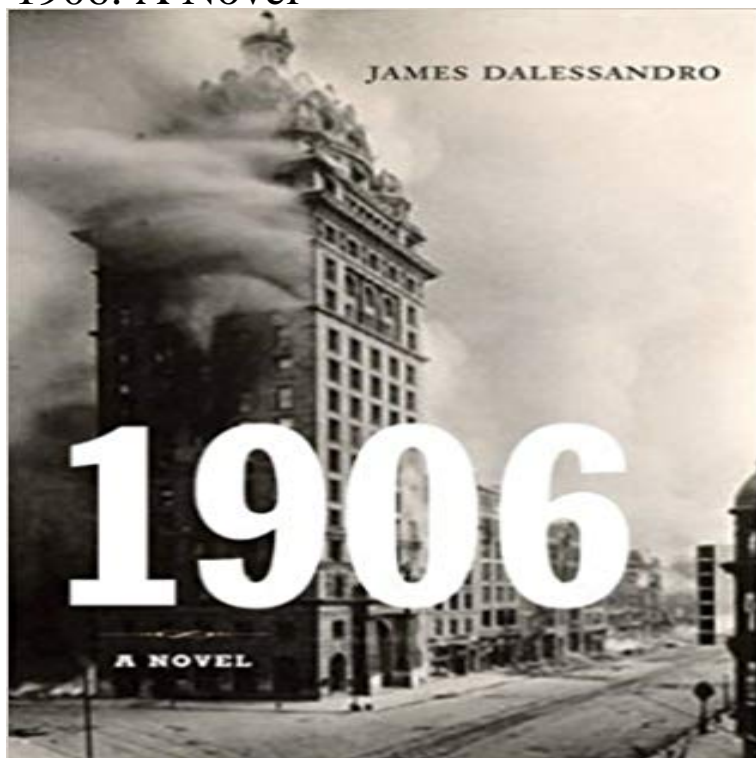


## 1906: A Novel
