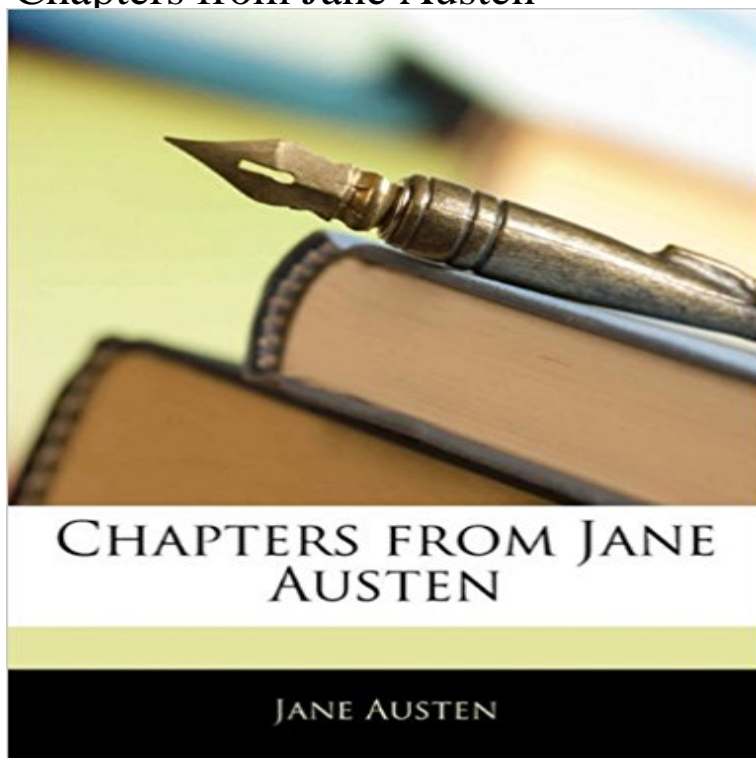


Chapters from Jane Austen
