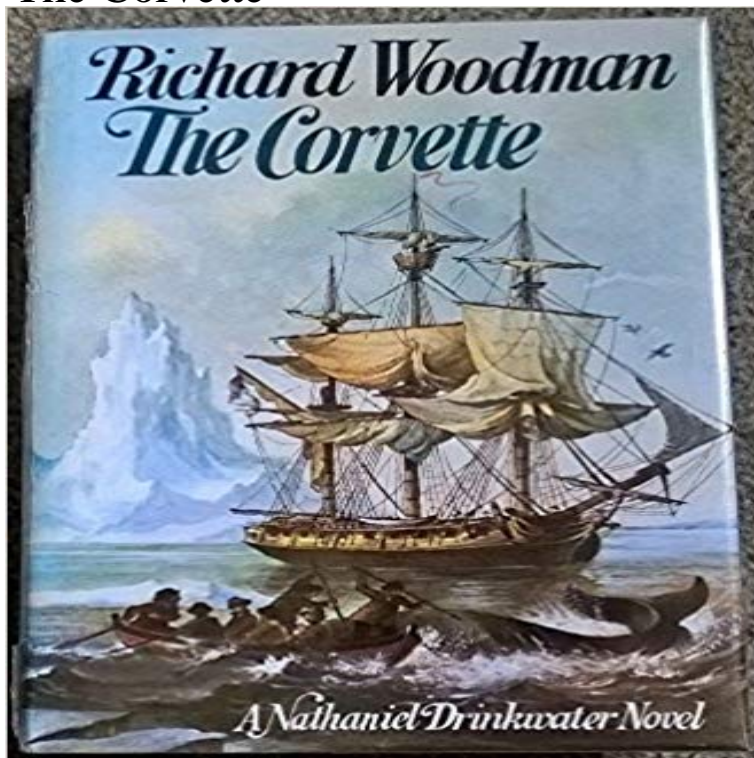


The Corvette
