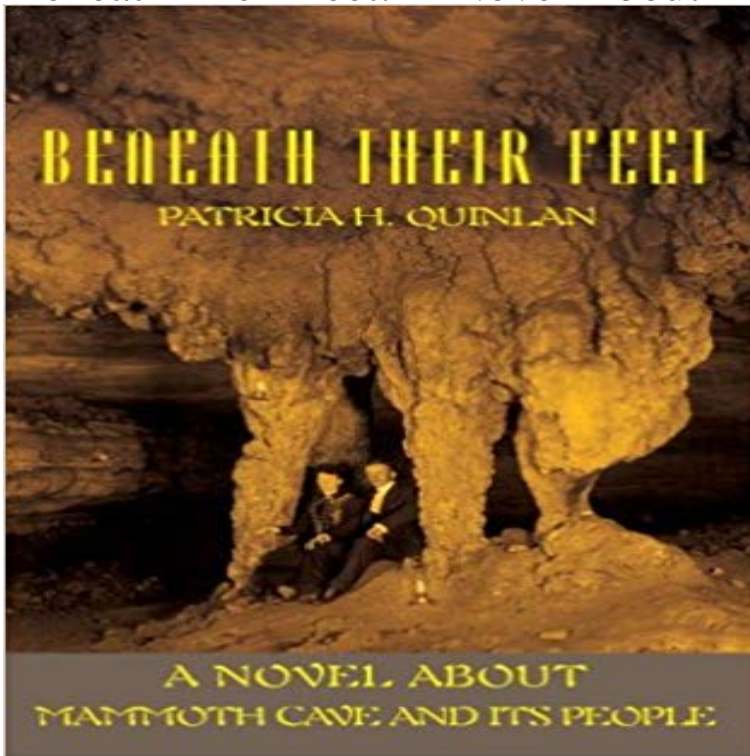


Beneath Their Feet: A Novel About Mammoth Cave and Its People
