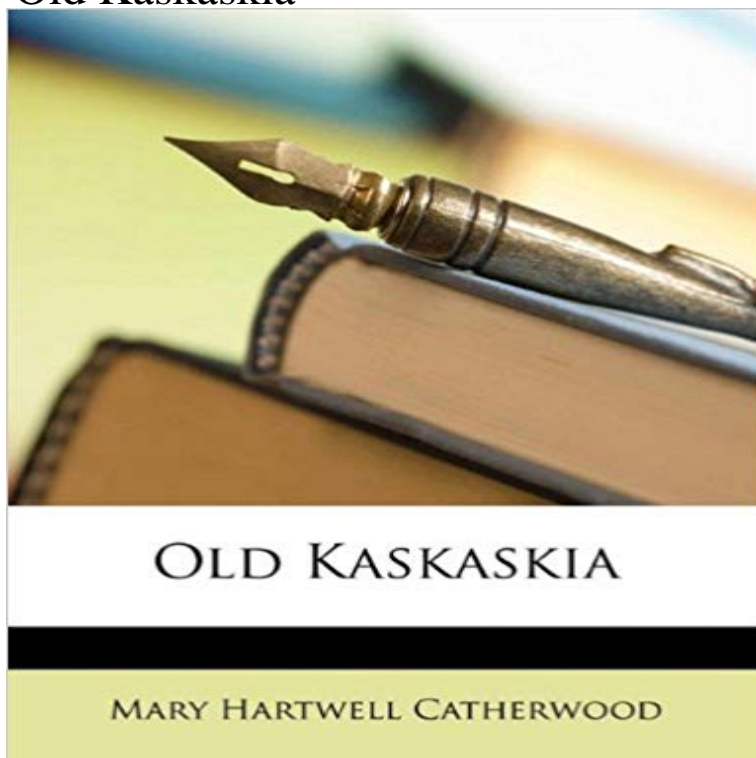


Old Kaskaskia
