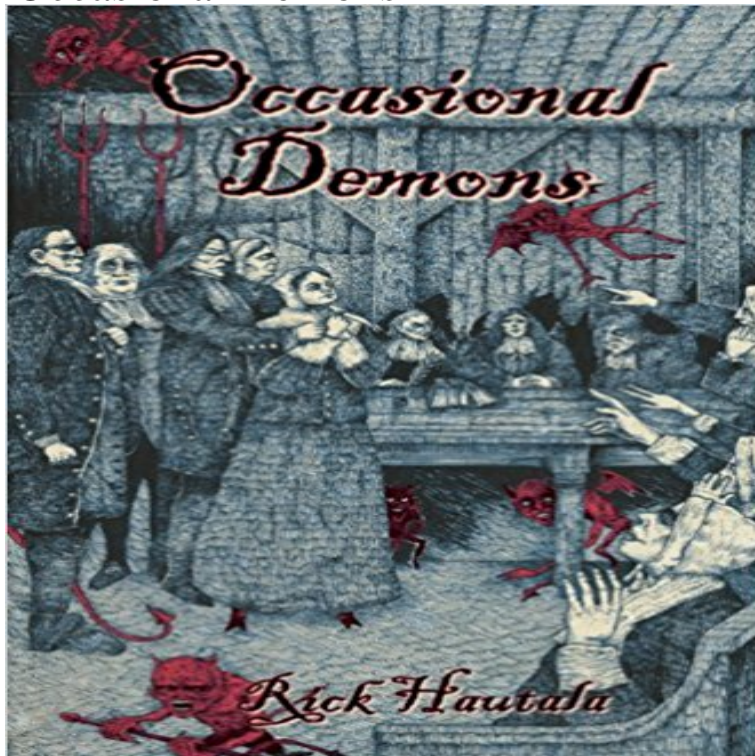


## Occasional Demons
