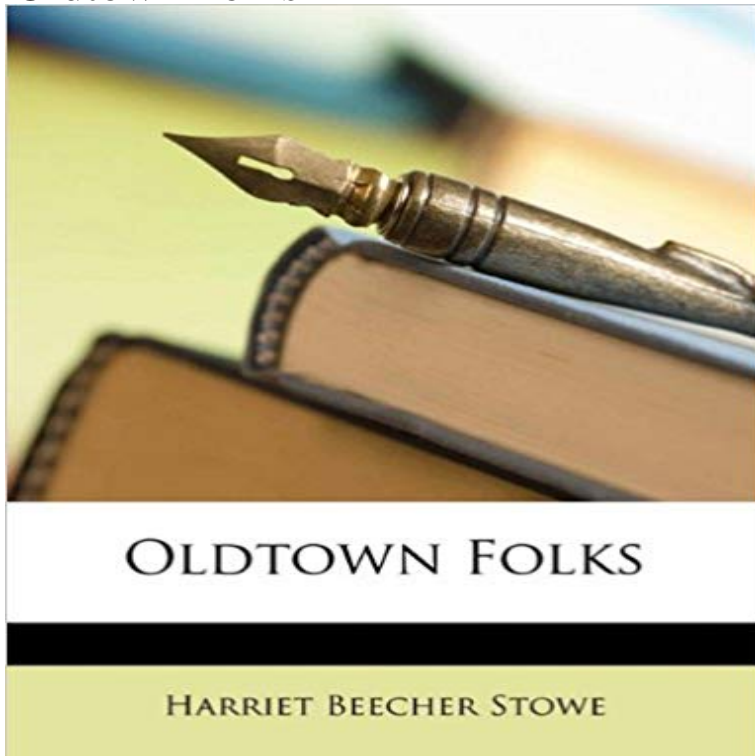


Oldtown Folks
