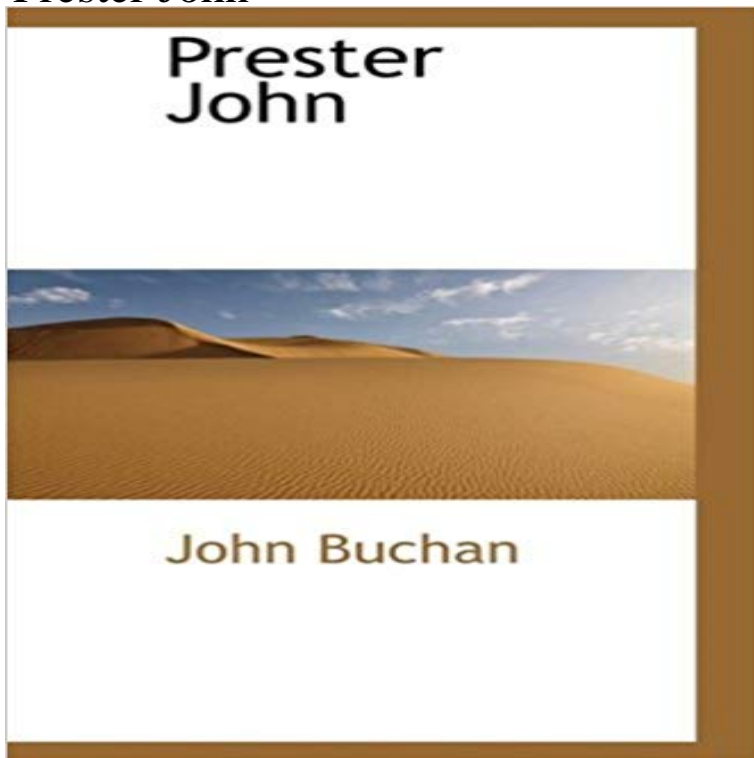


Prester John
