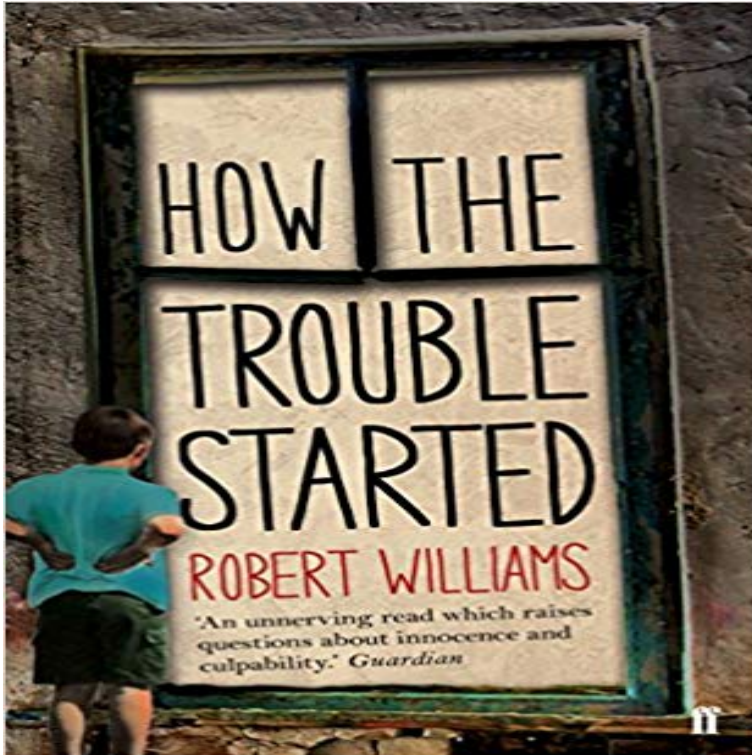


How the Trouble Started
