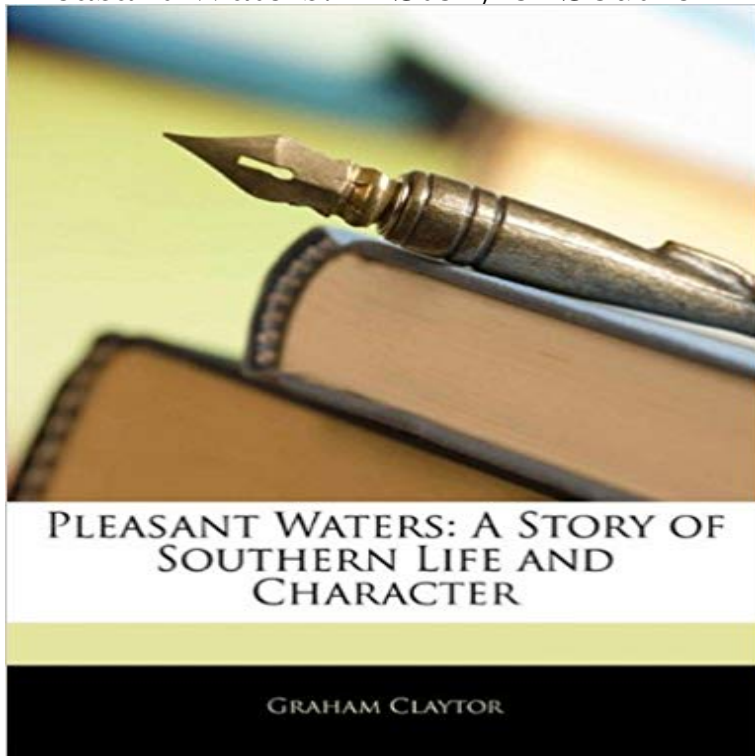


Pleasant Waters: A Story of Southern Life and Character
