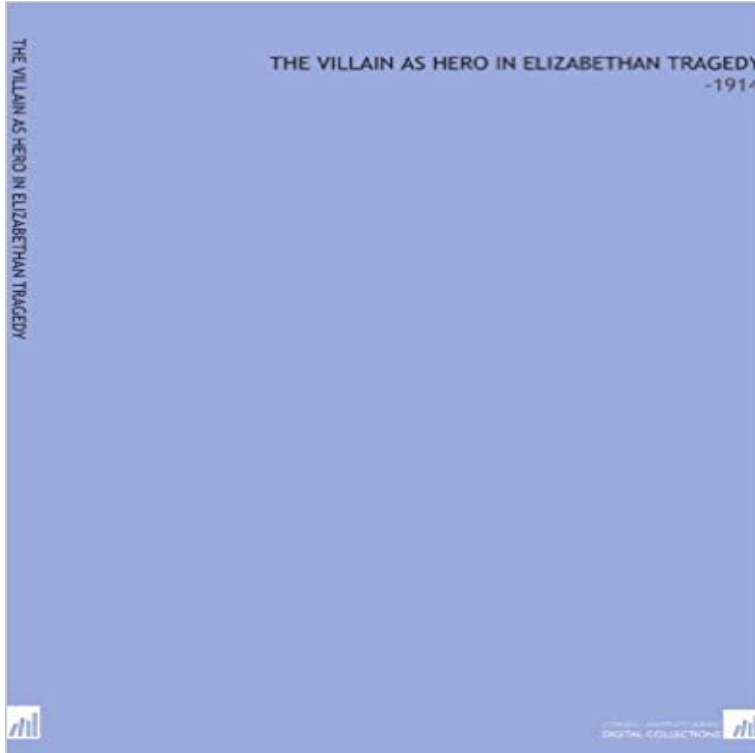


The Villain as Hero in Elizabethan Tragedy: -1914
