
Strangers to Ourselves: Discovering the Adaptive Unconscious

Citing evidence that too much introspection can actually do damage, Wilson makes the case for better ways of discovering our unconscious selves. If you want to know who you are or what you feel or what youre like, Wilson advises, pay attention to what you actually do and what other people think about you.
