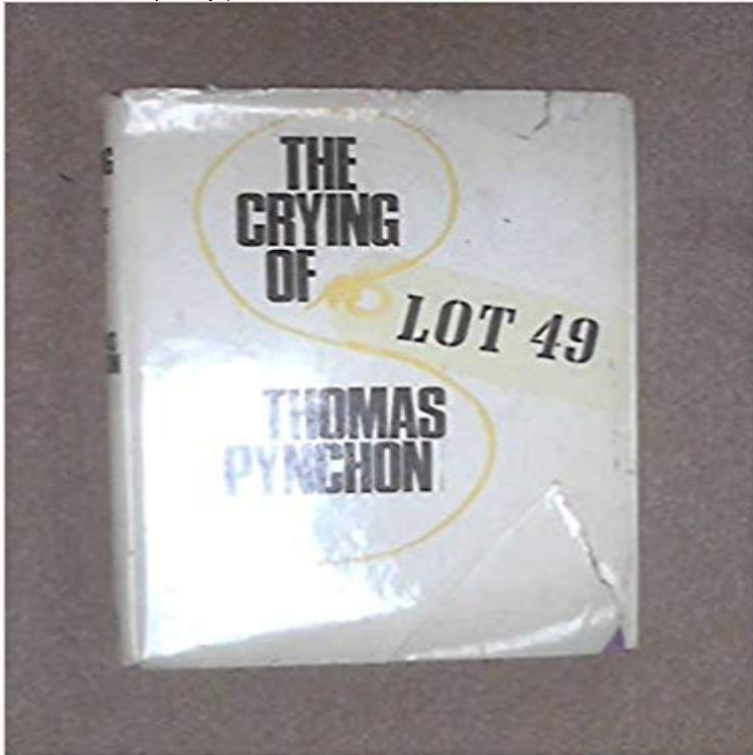


## The Crying of Lot 49
