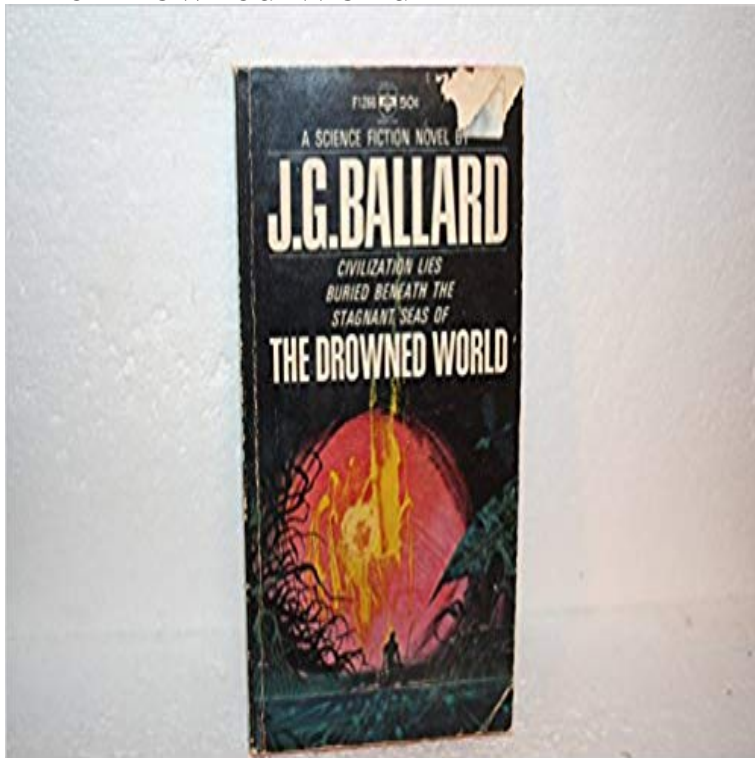


## The Drowned World
