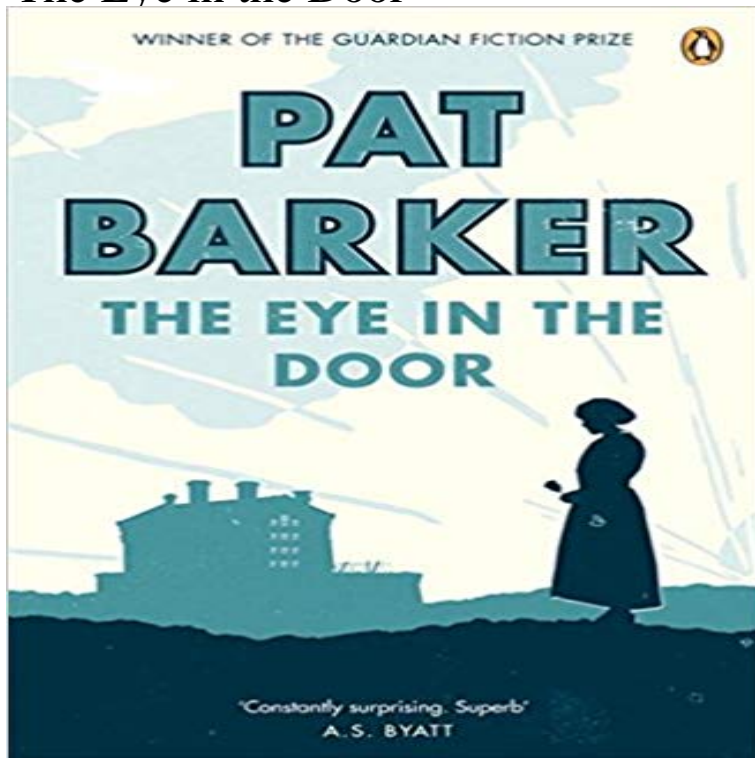


The Eye in the Door
