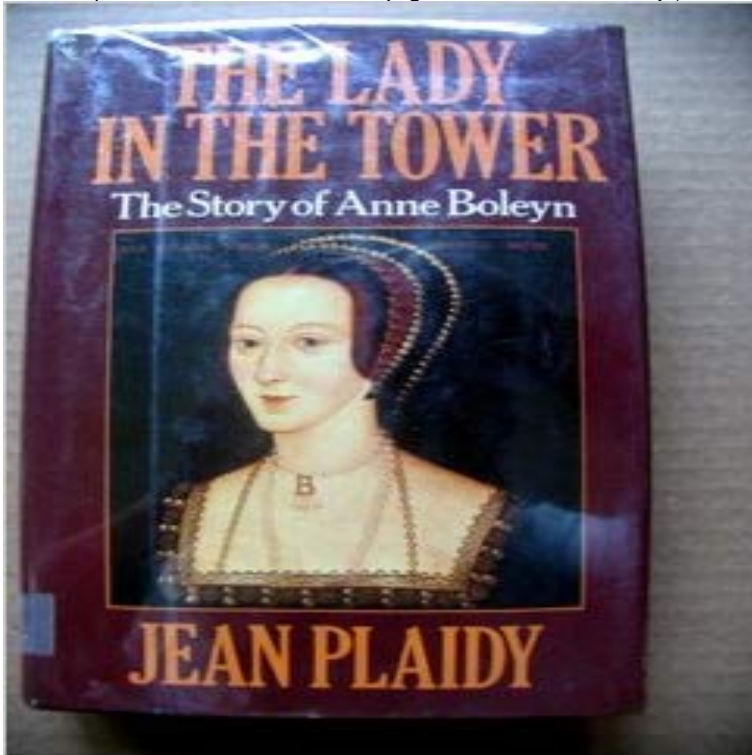


Lady in the Tower (Queens of England Series, Vol 4)
