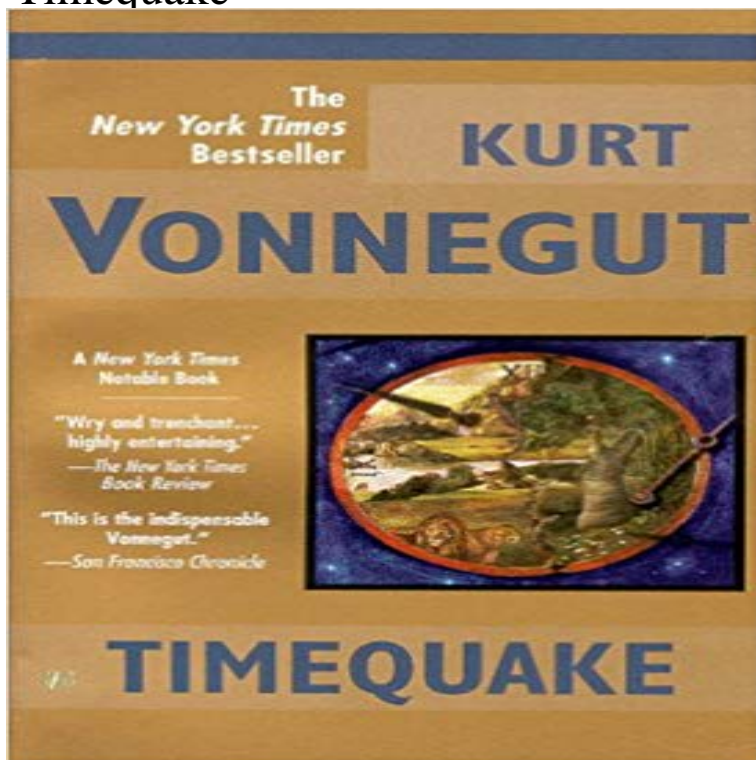


Timequake
