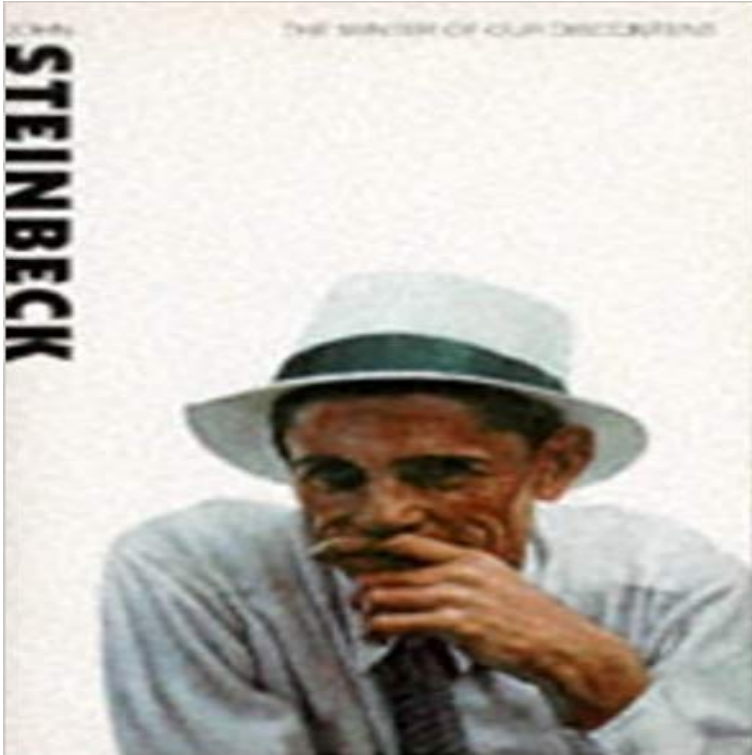


## The Winter of Our Discontent
