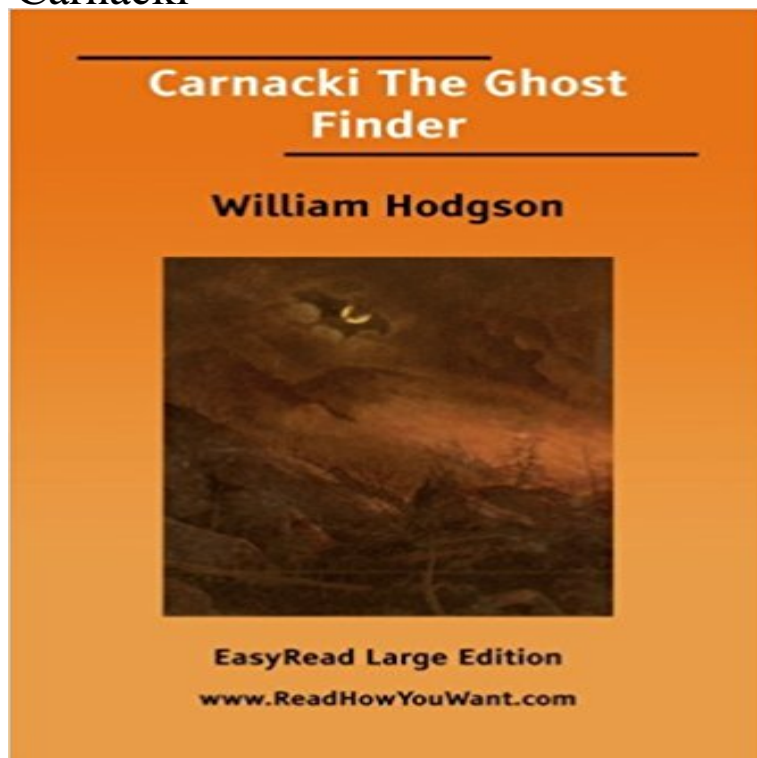


Carnacki
