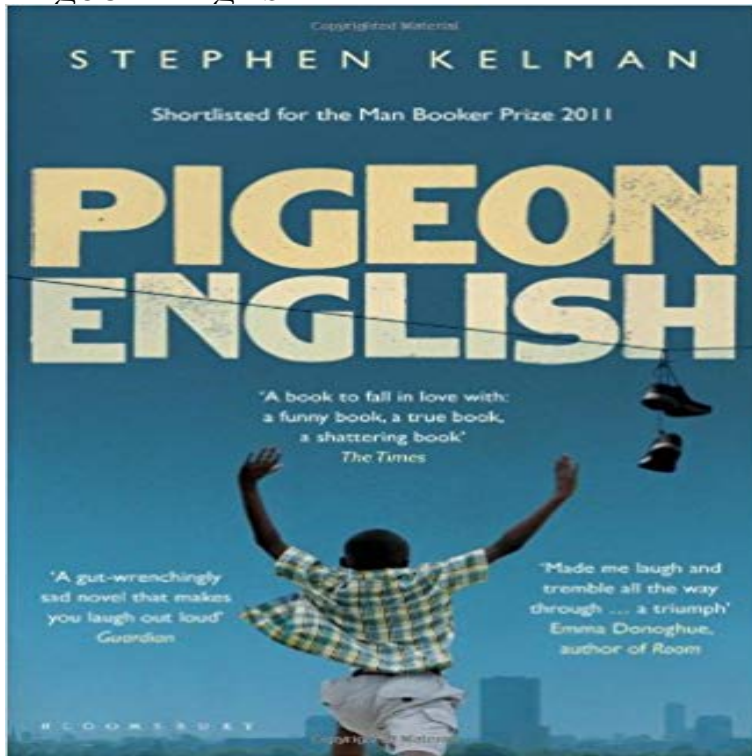


Pigeon English
