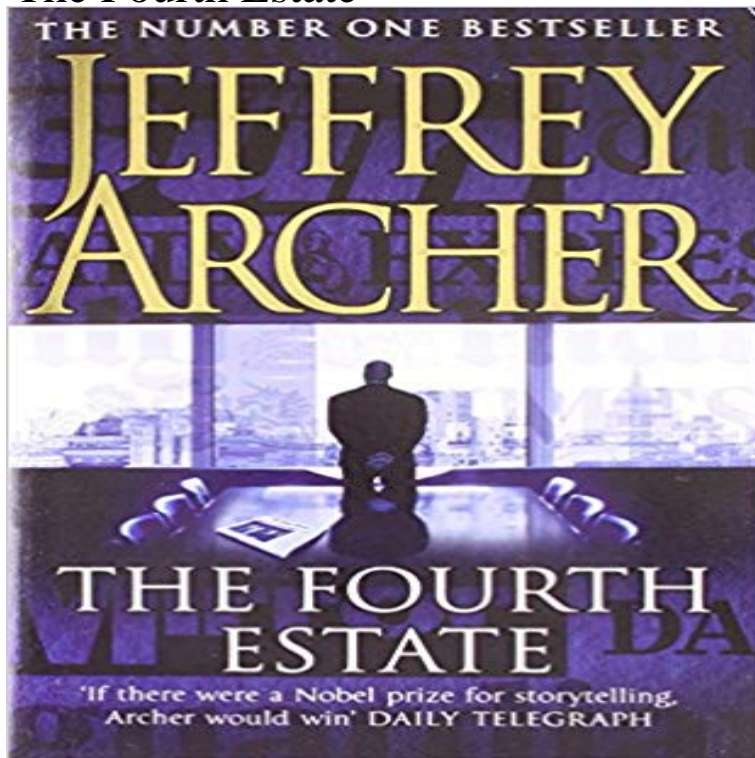


The Fourth Estate
